This project will turn Wahyu Lake into a community asset for generations to come.

The design draws from the International and Malaysian urban traditions of street, park, plaza, arcade and neighborhood. The promenade is designed to become the central heart of the community and the larger region. The design maximizes connectivity with regional transportation, 100% walkable connectivity, live-work-play functional inter-connectivity, connection to nature, as well as culture and a creative community.

The Plan creates a framework for achieving high performance sustainability and interoperability becoming a zero-carbon urban district. Smart City Technologies will enable the Eco-District to use technology, data and analytics to improve infrastructure and enhance services. Lake City will be the showcase city for the future of new urban development.
